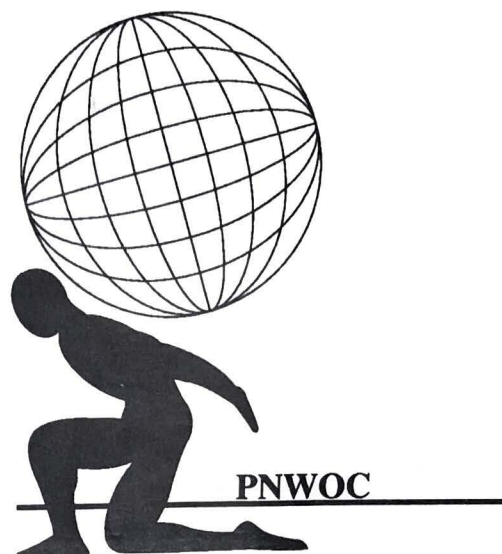


**The Second Annual
